

THE STORY OF YASSIN KWIKIRIZA

Kwikiriza Yassin is aged 5 years, he lives in Rwamwanja camp with his father Mr Bashil Mugume, Yassin lost his mother at the age of 3 and the poor Dad does not take care of Yassin.

During our cleft mobilisation we moved around the neighbourhood of Yassin giving information about the free services.



A concerned neighbour quickly referred us to Yassin and directed us to Yassin's home, the poor boy was present seated right at the veranda outside their home and doing at around 2:00 pm.

When we asked he when he had his last meal he could hardly remember, pity filled our eyes as we looked at this abandoned child, no mother, no care, and everything about him was really complicated.

The purpose of our approach was to help Yassin get free surgery for his clefts lip and palate but yet his condition was alarming, we bought Yassin some juice and cake which he ate before we left. And RSNF is committed to continue supporting this boy to start schooling, our social worker is in the process of finding the best school





And there after we had neighbours discuss among them about who would sacrifice to escort Yassin to hospital for his cleft surgery.

Later Abigel accepted to escort Yassin and we offered her transport, much thanks go to this lady for such a kind heart having to leave her family behind to nurse Yassin.



The two days Yassin spent at the hospital we watched him, poor boy has no smile on his face, he looks tired of the situation but no hopes for rescue.

Yassin has jiggers around his toes, his ears filled with soil no one shower him. Poor boy.
